

LEGISLATIVE BILL 384

AN ACT to amend section 43-111.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to infants; to clarify procedure for appointment of guardians where adoption is denied; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 43-111.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

43-111.01. If, upon a hearing, the court shall deny a petition for adoption, the court may take custody of the child involved and determine whether or not it is in the best interests of the child to remain in the custody of the proposed adopting parents. The court may also, on its own motion, appoint a legal guardian over the person and property of such minor and make disposition in the best interests of the child without further notice, relinquishments, or consents as may otherwise be required by sections 43-102 to 43-112.

Sec. 2. That original section 43-111.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
