## LEGISLATIVE BILL 226

Approved by the Governor April 28, 1975

Introduced by Kime, 43

AN ACT to amend section 70-624.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to public power districts; to change the maximum amount payable to members of the board and the president of districts having gross revenue not in excess of forty million dollars per year; to clarify existing language; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 70-624.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

70-624.02. The members of the board of directors shall be paid their actual expenses, while engaged in the business of the district under the authority of the board of directors, and, for their services, such compensation as shall be fixed by the board of directors, not exceeding one-hundred-dollars-per-month eighteen hundred dollars per year, as to all members except the president, and not exceeding one-hundred--fifty--dollars--per--month twenty-four hundred dollars per year as to the president; -as-shall-be--determined--by--the--board--of--directors; <u>Provided</u>, that when a district has gross revenue excess of forty million dollars per year, the board directors may <u>fix</u> receive such compensation not exceeding two-hundred-dollars-per-month <u>twenty-four hundred dollars</u> per year as to all members except the president, and not exceeding two-hundred-fifty-dollars-per-month three thousand dollars per year as to the president. 7--as shall-be-determined-by--the--board--of--directors. All salaries and compensation shall be obligations against, and be paid solely from, the revenue of the district. No director shall receive any other compensation from district, except as provided in this section, during the term for which he was elected or appointed or in the year following the expiration of his term, and resignation from such board of directors shall not be construed as the termination of the term of office for which he elected or appointed. A director member of the board of directors of a public power district organized under laws of this state shall not be limited to service on the board of directors in the district in which he has been elected, but may serve so as to preclude service similar positions of trust on a state, regional, or

national level which are the result of his membership as a director on such board. For time expended in his duties in such position of trust, the director shall not be limited to any existing provisions of law of this state relating to payment of per diem for services as a member of such board of directors, but shall be entitled to receive such additional compensation as may be provided for the same such service, regardless of the fact that the per-diem such compensation may be paid from funds to which his district has made contributions in the form of dues or otherwise.

Sec. 2. That original section 70-624.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
