AN ACT to amend section 84-908, Revised Statutes
Supplement, 1974, relating to rules of
administrative agencies; to increase the
membership on the Legislature's Committee on
Administrative Agency Rules and Regulations;
to provide for their election; and to repeal
the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 84-908, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1974, be amended to read as follows:

84-908. No adoption, amendment, or repeal of any rule shall become effective until the same shall have been approved by the Governor and filed with the Revisor of Regulations after a hearing has been set on such rule pursuant to section 84-907. After such hearing, any rule adopted by any agency shall be filed with the Revisor of Regulations and by that office referred to a committee of seven <u>nine</u> members of the Legislature to be known as the Legislature's Committee on Administrative Agency Rules and Regulations which is hereby created. appointed-by the Executive-Board-of-the-Legislative-Gouncil-at-the close-of-each-second-session-of-the-Legislature-to--serve until--the--end--of--the--second--session--of--the---next tegislature. At the commencement of each regular session in odd-numbered years the Legislature shall elect to the committee three members from each of the three congressional districts as such districts are constituted on the effective date of this act. Nominations for membership on such committee shall be made by the caucus for each congressional district. The committee shall organize by selecting a chairman and such officer or officers as it may deem necessary. Any vacancy on such committee occasioned by the fact that any member thereof is not a member of the next session of the Legislature shall be filled by appointment of the Executive Board from among members of the Legislature.

Sec. 2. That original section 84-908, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1974, is repealed.
