LEGISLATIVE BILL 507

Introduced by Koch, 12

AN ACT to authorize the Game and Parks Commission to acquire described property for prescribed purposes; to provide for the operation thereof; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The Game and Parks Commission is hereby authorized to acquire, using funds received from the federal Land and Water Conservation Fund, other applicable federal aid funds, and donations or bequests, the following described property, all in Sarpy County:

The northeast quarter and the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 19, township 14 north, range 14 east, the north half and the north half of the south half of section 20, township 14 north, range 14 east, and the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section 18, township 14 north, range 14 east.

The Game and Parks Commission may enter into agreements or leases with political subdivisions or nonprofit corporations for the operation and development of the property for recreational and educational purposes, but the commission shall be responsible for the general administration and continued maintenance of such property and may accept jifts, grants, and bequests for such purposes.

Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
