LEGISLATIVE BILL 643

Approved by the Governor April 24, 1978

AN ACT relating to county government; to remove a limitation on a fund; to add an additional purpose for a tax levy; to amend section 23-106, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 77-1605.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, as amended by section 218, Legislative Bill 42, Eighty-fifth Legislature, First Session, 1977; to provide severability; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 23-106, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

- 23-106. (1) The county board shall manage the county funds and county business except as otherwise specifically provided.
- (2) The county board shall have the authority to establish a petty cash fund for such county for the purpose of making payments for subsidiary general operational expenditures and purchases. Such county board shall set, by resolution of the board, the amount of money,—not—to—exceed—twenty—five—dollars, to be carried in such petty cash fund and the dollar limit of an expenditure from such fund and such amount shall be stated in the fiscal policy of the county board budget message.
- Sec. 2. That section 77-1605.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, as amended by section 218, Legislative Bill 42, Eighty-fifth Legislature, First Session, 1977, be amended to read as follows:
- 77-1605.01. The county boards of the several counties are authorized to levy a tax upon the actual value of all the taxable property in such county, except intangible property, in addition to all other levies authorized by law, for the purpose of raising funds for the construction or improvement of any of the county roads or city streets within the respective counties. The funds raised by such special levy may be used by the county independently or for cooperative projects with the

government of the United States or with any political or governmental subdivision of a state. Such funds shall be used for necessary road, street, and bridge purposes.

Sec. 3. If any section in this act or any part of any section shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions thereof.

Sec. 4. That original section 23-106, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 77-1605.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, as amended by section 218, Legislative Bill 42, Eighty-fifth Legislature, First Session, 1977, are repealed.
