

LEGISLATIVE BILL 456

Approved by the Governor April 14, 1987

Introduced by Smith, 33

AN ACT relating to the Department on Aging Advisory Committee; to amend section 68-1101, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change the membership of the committee; to eliminate certain districts; and to repeal the original section, and also section 68-1102, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 68-1101, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

68-1101. There is hereby created the Department on Aging Advisory Committee. The members of the Nebraska Commission on Aging serving on July 17, 1982, shall be the initial members of such committee. The Commencing on the effective date of this act, the committee shall consist of twelve members, two one from each of the planning and service areas as designated in the Nebraska Community Aging Services Act five districts provided for by section 68-1102 and two from the remaining members from the state at large. In making the initial appointments one member from each district and one member at large shall be appointed for two years and one member from each district and one member at large shall be appointed for four years-

Any member serving on the advisory committee on the effective date of this act shall continue to serve until his or her term expires. As the terms of the members expire, the Governor shall, on or before March 1 of each such year, appoint or reappoint a member of the committee for a term of four years, to succeed the member whose term expires. Each area agency on aging serving a designated planning and service area shall recommend to the Governor the names of persons qualified to represent the senior population of the planning and service area. Any vacancy on the committee shall be filled for the unexpired term. A vacancy shall exist when a member of the committee ceases to be a resident of the planning and service area from which he or she was appointed or reappointed. The members to be appointed to represent a planning and service area shall

must be residents of the district planning and service area from which they are appointed. Members of the advisory committee shall not be elected public officials or staff of the Department on Aging or of an area agency on aging. Any vacancy on the committee shall be filled for the unexpired term. A vacancy shall exist when a member of the committee ceases to be a resident of the district from which he or she was appointed or reappointed.

Sec. 2. That original section 68-1101, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and also section 68-1102, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
