AN ACT relating to cities and villages; to amend section 18-1214, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to provide additional uses for motor vehicle tax revenue as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 18-1214, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

18-1214. All cities and villages may levy a tax on all motor vehicles owned or used in such city or village, which tax shall be paid to the county treasurer of the county in which such city or village is located when the registration fees as provided in sections 60-329 to 60-339 are paid. Such taxes shall be credited by the county treasurer to the road fund of such city or village. Such funds shall, such funds to be used by such city or village exclusively for constructing, resurfacing, maintaining, or improving streets, roads, alleys, public ways, or parts thereof, or resurfacing dustless-surface street improvements on arterial rather than residential routes, and for the amortization of bonded indebtedness when created for such improvements, but not for maintenance nor purposes, or for related equipment purchases.

Sec. 2. That original section 18-1214, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
