Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 883 proposes to remove existing handgun purchase requirements, modify and transfer provisions concerning criminal history records checks for firearms and explosives, introduce penalties for violations, and ensure consistency across related legal provisions.

The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) states the approval/disqualification process involves the Electronic Commitment Reporting Application (ECRA) and the FBI's National Instant Criminal Background System (NICS). LB883 expands the mental health conditions covered by ECRA. Upgrades and maintenance of ECRA are currently supported by the NICS Act Record Improvement Program (NARIP). The enhancements required by LB883 need NARIP's approval, followed by updates to ECRA's specifications and budget. The total costs for these upgrades are not yet determined.

Implementing these changes will necessitate additional efforts from the Behavioral Health (BH) department, including providing new materials, training court clerks, and ensuring data accuracy. LB883 also removes the semi-annual reporting obligations for BH and NSP.

Cost breakdown:

- Estimated Costs: \$240,000 for initial tech analysis and development of the application portal, with \$200,000 allocated for 2
 Technical Analysts and \$40,000 for a Business Analyst.
- Absorbed Costs: \$12,212 for BH's initial preparations and manual updates, including payments to a Data Administrator and an Administrative Technician.

Unspecified costs include staff time for training, technical support, data checks, space rental, and training materials.

The Supreme Court states that the impact on the judicial workload will be more noticeable in larger jurisdictions but is expected to be minimal across the state. There will be a slight decrease in revenue and minimal fiscal implications for offering judicial education. Additionally, no extra resources are necessary to implement these changes.

Some Counties could have a loss in revenue. There is no basis to disagree with these estimates.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB883 repeals and amends statutes relating to the permits for or purchase of handguns, firearms, or explosives in addition to statutes relating to the approval/disqualification process by Nebraska State Patrol (NSP).

This approval/disqualification process uses the Electronic Commitment Reporting Application (ECRA) in conjunction with the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) National Instant Criminal Background System (NICS). The changes proposed by LB883 increases the scope of mental health circumstances that ECRA will cover.

Currently, ECRA is upgraded, supported, and maintained via the NICS Act Record Improvement Program (NARIP). Adding the additional upgrades designated by LB883 will require approval by NARIP then specification and budget revisions for ECRA. Currently, it is not possible to identify the full cost of these additional system upgrades.

Once these upgrades are implemented, staff-time from the department of Behavioral Health (BH) will be required to provide updated reference material, train the clerks of courts in data entry, and perform data integrity checks.

LB883 will eliminate the biannual reporting requirement for BH and NSP.
