Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 846 introduces the Bed Bug Detection and Treatment Act, detailing the responsibilities and procedures for tenants and landlords in managing bed bug infestations. This bill specifies tenant duties in reporting suspicions of bed bugs, outlines landlord responsibilities for inspection and treatment, establishes protocols for unit entry during inspections, prohibits renting units with known infestations, and defines legal consequences for non-compliance. The bill directs both parties participate in addressing and preventing bed bug issues in rental properties. There is no fiscal impact to the state.

There could be cost to counties but the amount is unknown.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 846 would create the Bed Bug Detection and Treatment Act. The legislation contains permissive language for an impacted tenant to contact the local health department. Such contact may result in additional costs for county departments of health. Further, there may be a slight increase in filing fees as a result of landlords seeking a court order to enter dwellings and engaging in bed bug inspection/treatment. The overall impact is unknown.
