Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill would modify and rename the Nebraska Opioid Recovery Fund as the Nebraska Opioid Recovery Trust Fund and create a new fund, the Opioid Cash Fund. The bill specified an undesignated transfer amount from the newly named Nebraska Opioid Recovery Trust Fund to the Opioid Cash Fund and be appropriated from there.

The State Fire Marshall which currently receives \$1,125,000 each year from the Nebraska Opioid Recovery Fund indicates there is no fiscal impact of the bill. Similarly, the Department of Health and Human Services is authorized to use the funds for specific uses, particularly for aid and for administrative costs consisting of one FTE to support the Overdose Fatality Review Team. Existing references to the Nebraska Opioid Recovery Fund would be void and result in decreased expenditures if references are not updated to reflect the fund's new name.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB1128 repeals sections of the Opioid Treatment and Recovery Act and renames the Nebraska Opioid Recovery Fund as the Nebraska Opioid Recovery "Trust" Fund.

LB1128 also creates the Opioid Cash Fund and directs the State Treasurer to annually transfer funds from the Nebraska Opioid Recovery Trust Fund to this Opioid Cash Fund.

All existing funds in the current Nebraska Opioid Recovery Fund would be transferred to this newly created fund.

- If the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) would retain access to these funds, this bill will not have a fiscal impact on DHHS.
- If LB1128 changes the spending authority and the fund is no longer assigned to DHHS, DHHS will lose all use and management of these funds. This will cause an immediate fiscal impact starting with a loss of an FTE budgeted for fiscal year 2025-2026.
