1 1. Strike the original sections and insert the following new
2 sections:

3 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$-0- from the General
4 Fund for FY2023-24 and (2) \$156,874 from the General Fund for FY2024-25
5 to the Department of Revenue, for Program 102, to aid in carrying out the
6 provisions of Legislative Bill 1331, One Hundred Eighth Legislature,
7 Second Session, 2024.

8 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
9 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
10 section.

11 Sec. 2. Section 53, Legislative Bill 1412, One Hundred Eighth
12 Legislature, Second Session, 2024, is amended to read:

23 Maintenance of Equity requirement for federal American Rescue Plan
24 Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Funds, which shall only
25 be used for such purpose.

26 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$235,724,424
27 General Funds and \$226,580,280 Cash Funds provided as state aid for
28 FY2023-24 for special education reimbursement. There is included in the
29 amount shown for this program \$235,724,424 General Funds and \$206,007,489
30 Cash Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for special education
31 reimbursement.

1 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$1,465,500
2 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$1,465,500 General
3 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 to carry out the provisions of
4 subsection (2) of section 79-734.

5 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$10,161,395
6 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$10,161,395 General
7 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for core services for
8 educational service units.

9 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$3,170,927
10 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$3,170,927 General
11 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for technology infrastructure
12 for educational service units.

13 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$281,654
14 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$281,654 General
15 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for distance education aid to
16 educational service units.

17 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$617,898
18 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$617,898 General
19 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for the school breakfast
20 program.

21 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$392,032
22 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$392,032 General
23 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for the school lunch program.

24 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$90,000
25 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$90,000 General
26 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for the Summer Food Service
27 Program.

28 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$214,664
29 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$214,664 General
30 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for adult basic education
31 programs.

1 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$750,000
2 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$750,000 General
3 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for aid to institutions
4 offering high school equivalency programs.

5 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$3,619,357
6 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$3,619,357 General
7 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for early childhood education
8 projects.

9 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$7,500,000
10 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$7,500,000 General
11 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for the Early Childhood
12 Education Grant Program for at-risk children from birth to age three. It
13 is the intent of the Legislature that a maximum of five percent of
14 General Funds appropriated each fiscal year for the Early Childhood
15 Education Grant Program for at-risk children from birth to age three may
16 be used for evaluation and technical assistance.

17 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$100,000
18 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$100,000 General
19 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for scholarships for early
20 childhood education providers.

21 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$69,000
22 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$69,000 General
23 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for incentive bonuses for
24 providers of child care and early childhood education programs.

25 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$400,000
26 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$400,000 General
27 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for the Nurturing Healthy
28 Behaviors program.

29 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$470,000
30 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$470,000 General
31 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for learning community aid.

1 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$2,342,962
2 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2023-24 and \$2,342,962 General
3 Funds provided as state aid for FY2024-25 for programs for learners with
4 high ability.

5 There is included in the amount shown for this program for FY2023-24
6 \$4,809,040 Cash Funds as state aid for career and technical education, to
7 be distributed between secondary and postsecondary schools according to
8 the formula used for federal Perkins funds as such formula existed on
9 January 1, 2023. Each school district shall receive no less than \$7,500.

10 There is included in the amount shown for this program for FY2024-25
11 \$4,809,040 Cash Funds as state aid for career and technical education, to
12 be distributed between secondary and postsecondary schools according to
13 the formula used for federal Perkins funds as such formula existed on
14 January 1, 2023. Each school district shall receive no less than \$7,500.

15 There is included in the amount shown for this program for FY2023-24
16 \$150,000 Cash Funds as state aid, to be evenly distributed between the
17 career education student organizations. There is included in the amount
18 shown for this program for FY2024-25 \$150,000 Cash Funds as state aid, to
19 be evenly distributed between the career education student organizations.

20 Sec. 3. Original section 53, Legislative Bill 1412, One Hundred
21 Eighth Legislature, Second Session, 2024, is repealed.

22 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed
23 and approved according to law.
