AN ACT to amend sections 81-8,266 and 81-8,267, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, relating to the Commission on Mexican-Americans; to provide for meetings at least twelve times a year; to increase compensation; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 81-8,266, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, be amended to read as follows:

81-8,266. The commission shall meet at least four twelve times a year. The chairman may call additional meetings. A majority of members shall constitute a quorum.

Sec. 2. That section 81-8.267, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, be amended to read as follows:

81-8,267. Members shall receive twenty-five thirty-five dollars per day for work-performed as part each day spent in the performance of their official duties. Hembers shall receive reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses on the same basis and subject to the same conditions as full-time state employees.

Sec. 3. That original sections 81-8,266 and 81-8,267, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, are repealed.
