AN ACT to amend sections 81-2,164.01 and 81-2,164.03,
Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943,
relating to agriculture; to expand a program
for the assembly and dissemination of
agricultural products information; to provide
for funds; and to repeal the original
sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 81-2,164.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

81-2,164.01. The Department of Agriculture is hereby authorized to cooperate with the federal government and the professions of assembling overnment and the professions of assembling and disseminating current and timely information, regarding prices and market conditions relating to poultry—and—eggs agricultural products produced, throughout the State of Nebraska. The department shall disseminate, without expense, through the newspapers, radio and television stations media, and—other news-distributing—agencies of ty telephone facilities designed for such purpose, timely reports of such information as will be of general value and benefit to the producers and dealers in poultry—and—eggs—and—will agricultural products to promote and assist the general velfere—of—the-poultry agriculture industry.

Sec. 2. That section 81-2,164.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

81-2,164.03. The Director of Agriculture is hereby authorized to receive voluntary gifts and contributions from the federal government, private agencies, farm industry associations, and individuals for the purpose of defraying the expenses of carrying out the provisions of sections 81-2,164.01 to 81-2,164.03. All advances so received shall be credited to the Poultry-and figs Agricultural Products Marketing Information Fund which fund is herely created. Distursements from such

fund shall be made upon vouchers approved by the director and warrants issued thereon as provided by law. All money received from the federal government, local government agencies, private research agencies, farm industry associations, or individuals, which are reimbursements for expenditures made shall be deposited in the state treasury and by the State Treasurer credited to the General-Fund Agricultural Products Marketing Information Fund.

Sec. 3. That original sections 81-2,164.01 and 81-2,164.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of Netraska, 1943, are repealed.
