

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 771

Approved by the Governor April 16, 1986

Introduced by Chizek, 31

AN ACT relating to law enforcement; to amend section 81-1444, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change a provision relating to bonds required for law enforcement reserve officers as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 81-1444, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

81-1444. No appointment of a law enforcement reserve officer shall be valid until a bond in the amount of two thousand dollars, payable to the county or city, has been filed with the clerk of the county or city by the individual appointed; which or a blanket surety bond arranged and paid for by the governing body and bonding all such officers of the governing body has been filed. Such bonds shall be subject to the provisions of Chapter 11, article 1.

Sec. 2. That original section 81-1444, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
