

AMENDMENTS TO LB 928

(Amendments to Standing Committee amendments, AM2435)

Introduced by Erdman, 47.

1 1. Insert the following new section:

2 Section 1. Section 30-2483, Reissue Revised Statutes of
3 Nebraska, is amended to read:

4 30-2483 Unless notice has already been given under this
5 article and except when an appointment of a personal representative
6 is made pursuant to subdivision (4) of section 30-2408, the clerk
7 of the court upon the appointment of a personal representative
8 shall publish a notice once a week for three successive weeks
9 in a newspaper of general circulation in the county announcing
10 the appointment and the address of the personal representative,
11 and notifying creditors of the estate to present their claims
12 within two months after the date of the first publication of the
13 notice or be forever barred. The first publication shall be made
14 within thirty days after the appointment. The party instituting or
15 maintaining the proceeding or his or her attorney is required to
16 mail the published notice and give proof thereof in accordance with
17 section 25-520.01. If the decedent was fifty-five years of age or
18 older or resided in a medical institution as defined in subsection
19 (1) of section 68-919, the notice shall also be mailed to the
20 Department of Health and Human Services with the decedent's social
21 security number and, if available upon reasonable investigation,
22 the name and social security number of the decedent's spouse if

1 such spouse is deceased.

2 2. Correct the operative date and repealer sections so
3 that the section added by this amendment becomes operative three
4 calendar months after the adjournment of this legislative session.

5 3. Renumber the remaining sections and correct internal
6 references accordingly.
