Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 749 relates to licensure to conduct, operate, and maintain a mobile home park. The bill permits applications for such licensure to be submitted electronically. The bill also permits the Department of Health and Human Services to impose a civil penalty of up to \$2,000 per day for certain acts as prescribed, in addition to other existing disciplinary actions that may be taken against a license for such acts.

LB 749 outright repeals section 71-4628.¹

Explanation of amendments, if any:

The committee amendment (AM 1541) directs that any civil penalties collected under the bill be remitted to the State Treasurer “for distribution in accordance with Article VII, section 5, of the Constitution of Nebraska.”
