A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act; to amend
2 section 53-172, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3 eliminate a restriction on adding alcohol to beer; to repeal
4 the original section; and to outright repeal section 53-174,
5 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 53-172, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 53-172. No manufacturer or wholesaler shall sell or deliver
4 any original package containing alcoholic liquor, except beer and
5 wine, manufactured or distributed by him or her unless the package has
6 affixed thereto a clear and legible label containing the name and
7 address of the manufacturer, the kind of alcoholic liquor contained in
8 the package, and, in the case of alcoholic liquor other than beer, the
9 date when manufactured. No original package of alcoholic liquor shall
10 be delivered by any manufacturer or wholesaler unless the package is
11 securely sealed so that the contents cannot be removed without
12 breaking the seal placed thereon by such manufacturer, and no other
13 licensee shall sell, have in his or her possession, or use any
14 original package which does not comply with this section ~~and section~~
15 ~~53-174~~ or which does not bear evidence that such original package,
16 when delivered to him or her, complied with this section.

17 Sec. 2. Original section 53-172, Reissue Revised Statutes of
18 Nebraska, is repealed.
