**Introducer's Statement of Intent**  
**LB 312**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 312 changes several provisions relating to recall elections.

One of the changes clarifies when a recall election may be canceled. If the official whose removal is sought resigns before the election is held, the governing body may cancel the recall election if the election commissioner or county clerk is notified at least sixteen days prior to the election. If such notification is not received, the recall election will be held as scheduled.

Also, if a recall election is canceled, the political subdivision will be responsible for the costs incurred related to the canceled election.

Finally, the bill requires all resignations to be in writing.
