**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 705 allows an unlimited number of motor vehicles or trailers owned by a person to be issued Disabled Veteran specialty license plates.

The bill amends Sec. 60-3,124 to state any number of motor vehicles or trailers owned by the applicant may be so licensed at any one time. Current law only allows for one vehicle to be so licensed.

**Other Information**

The same change was made for Purple Heart specialty plates during the 2007 session.
