Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 988 would increase the amount of credit for imprisonment for nonpayment of a fine or cost or for default on an installment plan used to pay a fine from the current daily amount of "\$60" to the new amount of \$80.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 1685 to LB 988 would change the amount listed on p.2, line 21 from "eighty" dollars to "ninety" dollars.
