A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to teachers; to amend section 79-1035.02,
2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide
3 requirements for use of funds distributed from the
4 temporary school fund; and to repeal the original
5 section.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 79-1035.02, Reissue Revised Statutes
2 of Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 79-1035.02 The temporary school fund is the holding fund
4 to which the interest, dividends, and any other income from the
5 permanent school fund, the net income from the school lands,
6 and the money from all other sources required or provided by
7 law are credited as described in Article VII, section 9, of the
8 Constitution of Nebraska. The entire balance of the temporary
9 school fund, including all interest and any other income therefrom,
10 shall be exclusively used for the support and maintenance of the
11 common schools in each public school district in the state as the
12 Legislature provides, in accordance with Article VII, section 9,
13 of the Constitution of Nebraska, and shall be distributed to each
14 public school district annually. Each district shall expend such
15 funds only for enhancement of the salaries of certificated teachers
16 under contract with the district. Such salary enhancement funds
17 shall be paid to such certificated teachers in addition to the
18 compensation agreed upon between such teachers and the district in
19 the contract of employment described in sections 79-817 to 79-821.
