Introducer's Statement of Intent
LB 782

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 782 requires all governmental units to display a distinctive license plate on any motor vehicle or trailer that they own, lease, or operate. The definition of governmental unit includes all current state and local political subdivisions.

Current statutory law allows the DMV to provide a distinctive license plate for motor vehicles owned or operated by the state, counties, municipalities, or school districts. LB 782 will expand the list to all political subdivisions, and makes the distinctive governmental unit plate mandatory.
