The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 926 seeks to allow informational sign panels along Nebraska roads that indicate to the traveling public there is a winery nearby in proximity in addition to informational sign panels presently available for gas, food, lodging or camping.

It also changes the hours open to the public that are required for a tourist oriented directional sign panel from eight hours per week to twenty hours per week.

The purpose of LB 926 is to encourage tourism for wineries in order to promote economic development in Nebraska.
