Introducer's Statement of Intent
LB 930

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 930 effects the Pharmacy Practice Act and the Wholesale Drug Distributor Licensing Act with regard to durable medical equipment and medical oxygen.

LB 930 amends the Pharmacy Practice Act to provide that a federal simplification of FDA device labeling will not in itself result in a requirement of a pharmacy license for businesses with proper accreditation selling durable medical equipment. The FDA requires these items to either be sold by a licensed practitioner or, if sold by someone else, sold only on the order of a licensed practitioner, but does not require that the items be dispensed pursuant to prescription.

LB 930 brings the Wholesale Drug Distributor Licensing Act into conformity with current state law section 38-2850 (12) enacted last year by recognizing the exemption enacted into the Pharmacy Practice Act for persons or businesses with proper accreditation who provide medical oxygen to home health patients.
