Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1049 is a bill that amends or implements the following changes to the Nebraska statutes:

69-401

Amends the definition of "regulated metal" to include manhole covers and sewer grates within the definition.

Creates New Section

To prohibit a secondary metals recycler from purchasing or receiving any manhole cover or sewer grate except from: 1) a representative of the political subdivision that owns the manhole cover or sewer grate as is evidenced by the stamping or the engraving on the cover or grate or; 2) a third party who has a legitimate bill of sale or letter of authorization from the political subdivision.

Payment for a manhole cover or sewer grate shall be made by check and sent through the U.S. Mail to the finance department of the political subdivision or to the third-party seller.

69-404

Amends this section to provide that copper purchases of more than \$150 shall be paid by check through the mail with the postage prepaid. 69-407 through 69-409 is amended to reference the newly created section through out these sections.
