**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 131 strikes obsolete language pertaining to completed transfers in the section of statute that creates the Cash Reserve Fund.

---

**Explanation of amendments:**

The amendment becomes the bill and reflects the Appropriations Committee recommendations, which make the following changes to the bill:

Deletes obsolete language related to transfers that have been completed in prior years.

Transfers \$80 million from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction Fund for certain University of Nebraska, Nebraska State Colleges capital construction projects and for a state contribution to the Centennial Mall project.

Transfers \$1 million from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund.

The emergency clause is added.
