## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 19 would add the following synthetically produced cannabinoids to the list of Schedule I controlled substances under the Uniform Controlled Substances Act as listed under Neb. Rev. Stat. 28-405:

Tetrahydrocannabinols;

Naphthoylindoles;

Naphthylmethylindoles;

Naphthoylpyrroles;

Naphthylideneindenes;

Phenylacetylindoles;

Cyclohexylphenols;

Benzoylindoles

LB 19 provides that the penalties for possessing, manufacturing or distributing the listed synthetically produced

cannabinoids under this bill, will be the same as the possession, manufacturing or distribution of marijuana.	
Penalties for possession of any amount of synthetic cannabinoids & marijuana less than a	an ounce:
1st Offense: Infraction, receive a citation, \$300 fine and attend a drug and alcohol course	at judge's discretion.
2nd Offense: Class IV misdemeanor, receive citation, \$400 fine and a maximum of five da	ays imprisonment.
3rd & Subsequent Off: Class IIIA misdemeanor, receive citation, \$500 fine and imprisonment.	a maximum of seven days
