## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 366 would eliminate the requirement that the Nebraska Environmental Trust Board have at least eight affirmative votes to deviate from a subcommittee recommendation regarding allocations from the endowment fund.

Section 1 amends 81-15,175, relating to allocations from the Nebraska Environmental Endowment Fund, by eliminating language allowing for a motion to deviate from a subcommittee's recommendations, with reasons stated, and for the motion to be adopted with at least eight board members voting in the affirmative.

Section 2 repeals the original section.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

AM122 requires that all subcommittee meetings be subject to the Open Meetings Act, requires that rules and regulations provide for a public hearing on proposed projects and funding, and requires the board to wait at least 30 days before making decisions on projects.
