## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 841 restricts the current sugar beet hauler exemption for length and weight to 15 percent extra weight and 10 percent greater length for a distance of up to 70 miles.

The bill amends Sec. 60-6,298 with relation to obtaining a special permit to operate a longer combination vehicle for a distance of up to 70 miles, to or from the field, loaded up to 15 percent greater and/or up to 10 percent greater length than the statutory maximum.

The current statute allows a vehicle carrying sugar beets to exceed the statutory maximum length by up to 25 percent.

The bill also restricts the length of a permit under this situation to a maximum of 120 days. Current law allows a maximum of 210 days.
