A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to amend sections 2-3745, 2-3746,
 2 2-3747, 2-3748, and 2-3749, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska; to change Dry Bean Commission provisions; to
 harmonize provisions; to repeal the original sections;
 and to declare an emergency.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 2-3745, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 2-3745 There is hereby created the Dry Bean Commission
- 4 which shall be composed of nine members, two of whom shall be
- 5 selected by the commission and seven of whom shall be appointed by
- 6 the Governor. Commission members shall be appointed on a nonpartisan
- 7 <u>basis.</u> Six members shall be growers who (1) are citizens of Nebraska,
- 8 (2) are at least twenty-one years of age, (3) have actually been
- 9 engaged in growing dry beans in this state for at least three years,
- 10 and (4) derive a substantial portion of their income from growing dry
- 11 beans. Three members shall be dry bean processors who have been in
- 12 business in Nebraska for at least three years, and the Director of
- 13 the University of Nebraska Panhandle Research and Extension Center
- 14 shall be an ex officio member but shall have no vote in commission
- 15 matters.
- 16 Sec. 2. Section 2-3746, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 17 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 18 2-3746 (1) One grower shall be appointed The Governor
- 19 <u>shall appoint one grower member</u> from each of the following four
- 20 districts:
- 21 (a) District 1 which shall consist of the counties of
- 22 Sioux, Dawes, Sheridan, and Box Butte;
- 23 (b) District 2 which shall consist of the county of
- 24 Scotts Bluff;
- 25 (c) District 3 which shall consist of the counties of

- 1 Banner, Morrill, Kimball, Cheyenne, Garden, and Deuel; and
- 2 (d) District 4 which shall consist of the remaining
- 3 counties in which dry bean production occurs in the state.
- 4 (2) The commission shall appoint two grower members to
- 5 the commission, one of whom resides within district 1 or 2 who shall
- 6 represent districts 1 and 2 and one of whom resides within district 3
- 7 or 4 who shall represent districts 3 and 4. Members serving as
- 8 representatives of such districts on the effective date of this act
- 9 shall continue as members of the commission until the end of their
- 10 terms and until their successors are appointed and qualified and,
- 11 <u>except as provided in section 2-3748, shall be eligible for</u>
- 12 <u>reappointment</u>.
- 13 $\frac{(2)-(3)}{(2)}$ The <u>three</u> processor members of the commission
- 14 shall be appointed by the Governor. Insofar as possible, the
- 15 geographic locations of such appointed members shall be
- 16 representative of the Nebraska dry bean industry. Any processor may
- 17 place his or her name on a candidacy list for appointment as an
- 18 initial member of the commission by written notice to the Governor
- 19 and for subsequent appointments by written notice to the commission.
- 20 Sec. 3. Section 2-3747, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 21 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 22 2-3747 (1) Within sixty days after March 31, 1987, the
- 23 seven members specified in section 2-3746 shall be appointed by the
- 24 Governor. Within thirty days after the appointment of the initial
- 25 commission, the commission shall conduct its first regular meeting.

1 At the first regular meeting the commission shall select and appoint

- 2 two members to the commission. Such appointments shall be growers
- 3 appointed at large with one member representing districts 1 and 2 and
- 4 one member representing districts 3 and 4.
- 5 (2) Members shall be appointed on a nonpartisan basis.
- 6 Any grower candidate may place his or her name on a candidacy list
- 7 for appointment as an initial member of the commission for the
- 8 district in which he or she resides by filing a petition signed by at
- 9 least twenty five resident bean growers of such district with the
- 10 Nebraska Dry Bean Growers Association and for subsequent appointments
- 11 by filing such petitions and notices with the commission. The
- 12 Governor shall make appointments from the district candidacy list
- 13 unless there are no names on such list.
- Any grower may place his or her name on a candidacy list
- 15 for appointment as a grower member of the commission by filing a
- 16 petition signed by at least ten resident bean growers (1) from the
- 17 <u>district in which he or she resides for an appointment under</u>
- 18 subsection (1) of section 2-3746 or (2) from the district in which he
- 19 or she resides or the other district to be represented for an
- 20 appointment under subsection (2) of section 2-3746. The petition
- 21 shall be filed with the commission. The Governor and the commission
- 22 shall make appointments from the candidacy list unless there are no
- 23 <u>names on the list.</u>
- Sec. 4. Section 2-3748, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 25 Nebraska, is amended to read:

1 2-3748 (1) The initial term of office for members of the 2 commission shall be as follows: Two district members and one 3 processor shall be appointed for one year; one district member, one 4 processor, and one member at large selected by the commission shall 5 be appointed for two years; and one district member, one processor, 6 and one member at large selected by the commission shall be appointed 7 for three years. 8 (2) Except for the persons appointed to the initial 9 commission, the The term of a member of the commission shall be three 10 years and until his or her successor is appointed and qualified. No 11 member shall serve more than three consecutive three-year terms. 12 Sec. 5. Section 2-3749, Reissue Revised Statutes of 13 Nebraska, is amended to read: 14 2-3749 Whenever a vacancy occurs on the commission for 15 any reason, the Governor shall appoint a person with the same qualifications as the initial appointee unless the vacant position is 16 17 that of a member at large, appointed by the commission, in which case the appointment to fill such vacancy shall be made by the commission. 18 Sec. 6. Original sections 2-3745, 2-3746, 2-3747, 2-3748, 19 20 and 2-3749, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed. 21 Sec. 7. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect 22 when passed and approved according to law.
