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Section 1. Section 60-6,232, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 60-6,232 A rotating or flashing amber light or lights 4 shall be displayed on the roof of any motor vehicle being operated by 5 any rural mail carrier outside the corporate limits of any 6 municipality in this state on or near any highway in the process of 7 delivering mail.

8 A rotating or flashing amber light or lights may be 9 displayed on (1) any vehicle of the Military Department while on any 10 state emergency mission, (2) any motor vehicle being operated by any public utility, vehicle service, or towing service or any publicly or 11 12 privately owned construction or maintenance vehicle while performing 13 its duties on or near any highway, (3) any motor vehicle being operated by any member of the Civil Air Patrol, (4) any pilot vehicle 14 escorting an overdimensional load, (5) any vehicle while actually 15 engaged in the moving of houses, buildings, or other objects of 16 extraordinary bulk, including unbaled livestock forage as authorized 17 by subdivision (2)(f) of section 60-6,288, $\frac{1}{2}$ (6) any motor vehicle 18 19 owned by or operated on behalf of a railroad carrier that is stopped 20 to load or unload passengers, or (7) any motor vehicle operated by or 21 for a storm spotter as defined in section 3 of this act who is 22 activated by a local emergency management organization when he or she 23 is within five hundred feet of a location point designated by a local emergency management organization. 24
