The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 15 clarifies existing law that district court judgments may be enforced by garnishments across county lines without transcribing the judgment and paying a transcribed judgment filing fee in the county where the personal property or wages are located. County Courts already have the clear authority to issue garnishments across county lines under legislation passed in 2009. See LB 332, which was amended into LB 35 by AM 836.
