The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 198 requires all state-owned passenger cars purchased, leased, or approved for purchase or lease by the transportation services bureau to be one of the following:

- 1. Identified as Fuel Economy Leaders in the annual Fuel Economy Guide issued by the United States Environmental Protection Agency;
- 2. Flex-fuel vehicles;
- 3. Hybrid electric vehicles;
- 4. Electric or plug-in electric vehicles;
- 5. Hydrogen or fuel cell vehicles;
- 6. Other alternative fuel vehicles;

The chief of the transportation services bureau may exempt the purchase or lease or approval for purchase or lease of a state-owned passenger car from this requirement if he or she determines that the cost of compliance would exceed the projected gasoline consumption cost savings.
