FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section 28-1320.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to unlawful picketing of a funeral; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 28-1320.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

28-1320.02 For purposes of sections 28-1320.01 to 28-1320.03, the following definitions apply:

(1) Funeral means the ceremonies and memorial services held in connection with the burial or cremation of the dead but does not include funeral processions on public streets or highways; and

(2) Picketing of a funeral means protest activities engaged in by a person or persons located within three <u>five</u> hundred feet of a cemetery, mortuary, church, or other place of worship during a funeral.

Sec. 2. Original section 28-1320.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
