Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 203 would exclude "products" from being considered solid waste under the state's Environmental Protection Act, and would define "products" as materials that are an intended output of a fabrication, manufacturing, or production process, sold and distributed in the stream of commerce for consumption, use or further processing into another desired commodity, managed as an item of value in a controlled manner and not as a discarded material.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment replaces the introduced version of LB 203. AM 334 amends 81-1502, the definitions portion of the Environmental Protection Act, subsection (26), which defines "solid waste". New language adds that solid waste does not include slag, a product that is the result of the steel manufacturing process and is managed as an item of value in a controlled manner and not as a discarded material.
