Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 287 would amend various provisions of sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 which imposes a duty to vaccinate domestic pets against rabies and prescribing authorities and standards for performance and enforcement of the rabies prevention program. The bill would revise provisions that currently assign exclusive authority to acquire vaccine and to administer vaccination to licensed veterinarians. LB287 would allow these functions to be performed by licensed commercial breeders on their own animals if acting within the supervision of the breeder's veterinary care plan required by section 54-641.02 of the Commercial Dog and Cat Operator Inspection Act. Under the bill, breeders would assume a duty to keep vaccination records with the health records of animals vaccinated and to provide copies of vaccination records to the attending veterinarian.
