**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 859 (Krist): relating to the Health Care Facility licensure Act; to amend section 71-468, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012, and sections 71-467 and 71-469, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2013; to change provisions for onsite vaccinations at certain health care facilities; and to repeal the original sections.

The purpose of this bill is to amend sections 71-467, 468, and 469 to clarify that when a national shortage of vaccine exists or it is contraindicated in individual cases immunization under these sections will not be required.
