Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Prohibits public employers (State of NE or its political or governmental subdivisions) from requesting criminal background or histories from employment applicants until it has been determined that the applicant meets the minimum qualifications. Clarifies that the prohibition does not apply to law enforcement or any positions where federal or state law requires background checks or to positions where law disqualifies an applicant with a criminal background.
