Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB964 amends 40-102(2) to provide that when a claimant is not married, the homestead may be selected from any of his or her property.

LB964 removes the "head of family" for the exemption under 40-102(2) where under existing law, if the claimant is not married but is the head of a family or is over age sixty-five, the homestead may be selected from any of his or her family.

Head of family is defined under 40-115.
