## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LR 413 would request that USDA withdraw a proposed regulation to allow imports of fresh and chilled beef from a region of Brazil and that USDA adopt a rule to strictly prohibit imports of fresh and chilled beef from Brazil until Brazil is free of foot and mouth disease without reliance on vaccination.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

The committee amendment replaces text that would have asked USDA to adopt a separate rule specific to imports from the country of Brazil. The amendment instead asks the USDA not expand exceptions in 9 CFR 94.1 which imposes a general prohibition against imports of meat animals and products from nations or regions that are not recognized as disease free for foot and mouth disease to allow imports of fresh or chilled beef from the country of Brazil, or any region of Brazil, until the entire country is free of foot-and-mouth disease without reliance on vaccination.
