**LEGISLATIVE BILL 366A**

Final Reading

Introduced by Cook, 13.

Read first time April 24, 2013

A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in  
2 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 366, One  
3 Hundred Third Legislature, First Session, 2013; and to  
4 declare an emergency.  
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$52,980 from  
2 the General Fund for FY2013-14 and (2) \$42,290 from the General Fund  
3 for FY2014-15 to the State Department of Education, for Program 25,  
4 to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 366, One  
5 Hundred Third Legislature, First Session, 2013.

6           Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries  
7 and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not  
8 exceed \$24,152 for FY2013-14 or \$24,695 for FY2014-15.

9           Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$750,000 from  
10 the General Fund for FY2013-14 and (2) \$750,000 from the General Fund  
11 for FY2014-15 to the State Department of Education, for Program 158,  
12 to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 366, One  
13 Hundred Third Legislature, First Session, 2013.

14           There is included in the amount shown for this program  
15 \$750,000 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2013-14 and  
16 \$750,000 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2014-15 for aid to  
17 institutions offering high school equivalency programs.

18           Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated \$85,550 from the  
19 Education Innovation Fund for FY2013-14 to the State Department of  
20 Education, for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the provisions of  
21 Legislative Bill 366, One Hundred Third Legislature, First Session,  
22 2013.

23           There is included in the amount shown for this program  
24 \$85,550 Cash Funds provided as aid for FY2013-14 for aid to  
25 institutions offering high school equivalency programs to acquire and

1 upgrade equipment and software to administer examinations for  
2 diplomas of high school equivalency.

3                   Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect  
4 when passed and approved according to law.
