  annulment and dissolution of marriage reporting
  requirements; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 71-615, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 3 71-615 On or before the fifth day of each month, the
- 4 clerk of the district court of each county shall make and return to
- 5 the department, upon suitable forms furnished by the department, a
- 6 statement of each action for annulment or dissolution of marriage
- 7 granted in the court of which he or she is clerk during the preceding
- 8 calendar month. The information requested by the department shall be
- 9 furnished by the plaintiff or his or her legal representative and
- 10 presented to the clerk of the court. with the complaint. The
- 11 <u>information</u> requested by the department shall include information
- 12 regarding the legal custody, physical custody, and parenting time
- 13 determinations for each child, if any, who is affected by the action.
- 14 If, after reasonable attempts are made by the plaintiff or his or her
- 15 legal representative to attain such information, the information is
- 16 unavailable, the designation unknown shall be accepted by the
- 17 department. If no annulments or dissolutions of marriage were granted
- 18 in the county during the preceding month, a card furnished by the
- 19 department indicating such information shall be submitted on or
- 20 before the fifth day of each month to the department.
