A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds for the payment of the salaries and benefits of certain state officers for FY2013-14 and FY2014-15; to define terms; to provide an operative date; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. APPROPRIATION LANGUAGE.
- 2 There are hereby appropriated, for FY2013-14 and
- 3 FY2014-15, the amounts specified in this act, or so much as may be
- 4 necessary, for the salaries and benefits of officers of the Nebraska
- 5 state government.
- 6 Sec. 2. DEFINITION OF APPROPRIATION PERIOD.
- 7 For purposes of this act, FY2013-14 means the period
- 8 beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, and FY2014-15 means
- 9 the period beginning July 1, 2014, and ending June 30, 2015.
- 10 Sec. 3. NEBRASKA ACCOUNTING SYSTEM MANUAL DEFINITIONS.
- 11 The definitions contained in the Nebraska Accounting
- 12 System Manual, and any amendments thereto, on file with the Clerk of
- 13 the Legislature are hereby adopted by the Legislature as the
- 14 definitions for this act, except as provided in section 21 of this
- 15 act.
- 16 Sec. 4. DRAWING AND PAYING WARRANTS.
- 17 The Director of Administrative Services shall draw
- 18 warrants upon the proper fund in the state treasury for an amount not
- 19 to exceed the appropriations set forth in this act upon presentation
- 20 of proper documentation. The State Treasurer shall pay the warrants
- 21 out of the appropriate funds.
- 22 Workers' compensation premium assessments shall not be
- 23 paid from the programs listed in this act.

- 3 Sec. 21. LIMITATION ON SALARIES, WAGES, AND PER DIEMS.
- 4 (1) As used in this act:
- 5 (a) SALARY LIMIT means total expenditures for permanent
- 6 and temporary salaries and per diems; and
- 7 (b) Total expenditures for permanent and temporary
- 8 salaries and per diems means all remuneration paid to employees
- 9 treated as taxable compensation by the Internal Revenue Service or
- 10 subject to social security coverage, specifically including payments
- 11 accounted for as vacation, holidays, sick leave, military leave,
- 12 funeral leave, maternity leave, administrative leave, compensatory
- 13 time, deferred compensation, or any other similar form, and amounts
- 14 withheld pursuant to law, but excluding state contributions for
- 15 social security, retirement, and employee insurance plans.
- 16 (2) Total expenditures for permanent and temporary
- 17 salaries and per diems are limited to the amount provided by law for
- 18 constitutional officers.
- 19 (3) The limitation on expenditures for permanent and
- 20 temporary salaries and per diems for FY2013-14 shall be increased by
- 21 certified encumbrance amounts from FY2012-13 for permanent and
- 22 temporary salaries and per diems. The limitation on expenditures for
- 23 permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for FY2014-15 shall be
- 24 increased by certified encumbrance amounts from FY2013-14 for
- 25 permanent and temporary salaries and per diems. Encumbered amounts

- 1 shall be calculated in accordance with section 81-138.01.
- 2 Sec. 22. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2013.
- 3 Sec. 23. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 4 when passed and approved according to law.
