5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 48-152, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 48-152 Recognizing that (1) industrial relations between employers and employees within the State of Nebraska are affected 4 5 with a vital public interest, (2) an impartial and efficient administration of the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act is essential 6 7 to the prosperity and well-being of the state, and (3) suitable laws 8 should be enacted for the establishing and for the preservation of such an administration of the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act, 9 there is hereby created, pursuant to the provisions of Article V, 10 section 1, of the Nebraska Constitution, a court, consisting of seven 11 12 judges, to be selected or retained in office in accordance with the provisions of Article V, section 21, of the Nebraska Constitution and 13 to be known as the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court, which court 14 15 shall have authority to administer and enforce all of the provisions 16 of the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act, and any amendments thereof, except such as are committed to the courts of appellate 17 18 jurisdiction or as otherwise provided by law.

19The Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court shall have20authority to issue contempt orders and to sanction or otherwise21enforce conformity with a contempt order.
