| 8 | and their families. For purposes of this section, at-risk child or |
| 9 | youth means any child or youth whose mental health, substance abuse, |
| 10 | or behavioral issues have resulted or may potentially result in the |
| 11 | child or youth being provided care by or being under the supervision |
| 12 | of the child welfare system or juvenile justice system. |
