Section 1. Section 54-189, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 3 54-189 Satisfactory evidence of ownership consists of the
- 4 brands, tattoos, or marks on the livestock; point of origin of
- 5 livestock; the physical description of the livestock; and the
- 6 documentary evidence, such as bills of sale, brand clearance,
- 7 certificates of inspection, breed registration certificates, animal
- 8 health or testing certificates, recorded brand certificates, purchase
- 9 sheets, scale tickets, disclaimers of interest, affidavits, court
- 10 orders, security agreements, powers of attorney, canceled checks,
- 11 bills of lading, or tags. ; and such other facts, statements, or
- 12 circumstances that taken in whole or in part cause an inspector to
- 13 believe that proof of ownership is established.
- Sec. 2. Original section 54-189, Reissue Revised Statutes
- of Nebraska, is repealed.
