Section 1. Section 54-1,109, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 54-1,109 The brand inspection area of Nebraska consists 4 of the following land area of counties and parts thereof: Arthur, 5 Banner, Blaine, Box Butte, Boyd, Brown, Buffalo, Chase, Cherry, 6 Cheyenne, Custer, Dawes, Dawson, Deuel, Dundy, Franklin, Frontier, 7 part of the south half of section 1, township 3 north, range 21, on 8 railroad right-of-way in the west part of Oxford Town called Burlington addition in Furnas, Garden, Garfield, Gosper, Grant, 9 Greeley, all of lots 1, 7, and 8 in block 48 in original town of 10 Grand Island, and all of the southeast quarter lying south of the 11 12 Union Pacific Railroad Company's right-of-way in section 24, township 13 11 north, range 10, in Hall, Harlan, Hayes, Hitchcock, Holt, Hooker, Howard, Kearney, Keith, Keya Paha, Kimball, all of Knox except 14 15 Eastern, Dolphin, Dowling, Columbia, Morton, Peoria, Addison, 16 Herrick, Frankfort, and Lincoln townships, Lincoln, Logan, Loup, McPherson, Morrill, Perkins, Phelps, Red Willow, Rock, Scotts Bluff, 17 Sheridan, Sherman, Sioux, Thomas, Valley, the existing livestock 18 auction markets in Blue Hill, all of lots 1 to 6, and lots 7 and 8, 19 20 except twenty-two feet of the east side of lot 8, all in block 6, original town of Blue Hill, and Red Cloud, part of lot A, Roats 21 subdivision to Red Cloud, lots 1 and 2 and the south one-half of 22 23 block 32 in original town of Red Cloud, and all of annex lot 21, Red Cloud, in Webster, and all of Wheeler. 24
