Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1080 would amend the Plant Protection and Plant Pest Act by creating a section addressing nonprofit nursery stock distributors. LB1080 defines a nonprofit nursery stock distributor and exempts them from the Plant Protection and Plant Pest Act except for the provisions laid out in LB 1080.

LB 1080 requires nonprofit nursery stock distributors to register with the Nebraska Department of Agriculture by January 1 and to provide the department in writing thirty days prior to any fundraising sale. A nonprofit nursery stock distributor is allowed one fundraising sale event per year.

LB 1080 would allow the Nebraska Department of Agriculture to collect of fee of thirty-five dollars upon the inspection of nonprofit nursery stock distributor fundraiser. Upon inspection the department may require the treatment or destruction of any nursery stock that is infested, infected or nonviable.
