Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 998 would change provisions of law in that persons who operate a motor vehicle which is not equipped with an ignition interlock device in violation of a court order, Department of Motor Vehicles order, or Board of Pardons' order shall be guilty of a Class I misdemeanor.

Any such person that has a concentration of two-hundredths of one gram or more by weight of alcohol per one hundred milliliters of his or her blood or a concentration of two-hundredths of one gram or more by weight of alcohol per two hundred ten liters of his or her breath shall be guilty of a Class IV felony.
