Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB422 would amend the Nebraska Probate Code to provide that the reasonable fees and costs of an attorney, guardian ad litem, physician or visitor appointed by the court for a minor may be paid by the minor's estate or the county in which proceedings are brought.

Similar provisions already exist for guardianships and conservatorships in the Probate Code at 30-2620.01 for a person alleged to be incapacitated and at 30-2643 for a person to be protected.
